The 24 principles for international obsevation include, among others:

- IMPARTIALITY
- OBSERVE ENTIRE PROCESS
- FOCUS ON PROCESS NOT RESULTS
- REPORT FINDINGS ACCURATELY
- RESPECT HOST COUNTRY'S SOVEREIGNTY
- DON'T OBSTRUCT THE PROCESS
- DON'T GIVE LEGITIMACY TO UNDEMOCRATIC PROCESSES
